## General Information

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. STABLING: PERMANENT BOX STALLS WITH DOORS ARE AVAILABLE FOR \$75.00 for both shows (Wednesday through Sunday). Request all stalls on entry blank. Stall fees must accompany reservations. NO REFUNDS ON STALLS. Initial bedding is not included but may be pre-purchased for delivery to your stalls. Please order bags of shavings with your entries. Stalls are permanent 12 x 12.
3. EVERY ANIMAL NOT SHOWING FROM A STALL will be charged a \$15.00 trailer fee.
4. CAMPERS: There will be a \$100.00 fee for every camper. Spots include electric, sewer and Water. Please note that camper spaces are a ¼ mile from the barns. Please plan accordingly.
5. All Welsh ponies six years & over showing in breeding classes and all Welsh and half Welsh ponies showing in WPCSA performance classes must be measured or present a valid USEF or WPCSA measurement card. All ponies and cobs showing USEF days must show current USEF measurement cards or be measured at the show. Officials will be measuring on Saturday from 8:00-9:00am and again on Sunday from 7:00-8:00 am
6. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. All Prize money will be paid in the ring. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated.
7. The management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show. The management may decide to split a division that is listed in the prize list as having sections combined. In addition, USEF rules state that management must give 12 hours notice to the judge and exhibitors before changing the order of classes.
8. There will be a \$30.00 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank. All entries not paid in full at the show will be charged a \$25.00 billing fee.
9. All Welsh animals must be registered in the stud books of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of America, Inc., or the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Canada and must be entered under their full registered name, or if under one year, be eligible for registration.
10. Before numbers will be issued Exhibitors must provide the show office with a copy of breed registration papers, applicable Measurement cards, and any applicable USEF membership cards.
11. The Northeastern Welsh Pony Association and the show manager take no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to animals, exhibitors, equipment and anyone connected thereto.
12. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) headline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes. 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
13. **Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle while on the show grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.**
14. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASHES OR TIED IN A STALL AT ALL TIMES.
15. **ENTRIES CLOSE June 11, 2009. Once an animal is entered in at least one class, post entries will be accepted at the regular fee.** Post Entries accepted for new animals for an additional \$5.00/class above the regular entry fee.
16. All fees will be refunded if entries are cancelled on or before June 11. There will be a \$25 office charge for all scratches after June 11. No refunds on stalls. Once the show has started horses that are not shown in classes in which they are entered forfeit their entry fee except if a horse is injured or becomes ill. Proper notification by a veterinarian and a scratch sheet must be presented to the office prior to the start of the class being scratched.
17. Rings are 200' x 300' with all weather Euro felt footing
18. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. (If your competition bans motorized vehicles, please contact our office for further instruction.)

**Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.**

To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, working trot, trot on and slow trot (slower and more collected, but not to the degree required in the dressage collected trot. The animal should indicate a willingness to be driven on the bit while maintaining a steady cadence). To stand quietly and back readily. Turnout to be judged 70% on the condition, fit and appropriateness of harness and vehicle, neatness and appropriateness of attire and overall impression, 30% on performance, manners and way of going. Working class to be judged 70% on performance, manners and way of going; 20% on condition and fit of harness and vehicle; 10% on neatness of attire. Obstacle/Cones to be Judged 100% on performance. Obstacle Class is a timed competition, judged on speed through a course of no more than twenty obstacles. Faults add seconds to total time. Fastest time wins.

Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except My First Tandem Classic, costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk, and walk-trot poles.

### **472. WPCSA WALK-TROT POLES(Article 115.5) Entry Fee: \$15.00 per class**

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot or jog. Poles are to be placed a minimum of four feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle.

May be ridden at either a walk or trot. English or Western attire is acceptable. Rider ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk, walk-trot.

### **Open Walk Trot Division Entry Fee: \$15.00 per class**

Open to all Riders. Will be split 14 and under and 15 and over if entries warrant. Judged on equitation, performance and suitability of mount. Riders are ineligible for other ridden classes with cantering or jumping.

**481. WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT.** To walk. Trot or jog and stand quietly.

#### **482. WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT POLES**

This class is designed to be a beginning hunter class for the very young riders. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot or jog. Poles are to be placed a minimum of four feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle.

#### **483. WPCSA LEADING REIN (Article 115.1)** *Entry Fee: \$15.00 per class*

Section A, B, C or Half-Welsh, mare or gelding, 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but not more than eight, years of age. Riders to be suitably dressed in Hunt, Saddle or Western attire including protective headgear. To be shown at a walk, on the right rein (clockwise), to line up and stand quietly. Ponies will be called out individually to stand, walk out and trot or jog back past the judge. Ponies to be judged on manners, suitability, breed type, conformation and turnout.. This is not an equitation class.

### **MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES**

#### **488. COSTUME** *-No Entry Fee*

Open to All.. Animal to be ridden or led at a walk. Helmets required for all Junior riders if mounted.

#### **WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSICS** *Entry Fee: \$25.00*

Open to animals 4 years of age and over. To be judged 50% on performance and 50% on conformation. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter, displaying Welsh movement as described in the breed description. An individual performance showing all gaits in both directions by each participant will be required (the gallop need only be shown in one direction). Each animal will then be stripped for conformation judging. Once an entry has been judged for conformation it can be re-tacked. UK Judge or qualified American Judge to officiate.

#### **489. WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSIC SEC. C & D (Article 115.7)**

Open to registered Welsh Cobs and Welsh Ponies of Cob Type 4 years of age and over.

#### **490. WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSIC SEC. A & B (Article 115.8)**

Open to registered Welsh Ponies, Section A & B, 4 year of age and over.

#### **WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSIC CHAMPIONSHIP**

This class is for the first and second place winners from class 489 and 490. To be judged 50% on conformation and 50% on ridden performance. There is no entry fee for this class. Places will be awarded for Best Ridden and Reserve Best Ridden. Any animal in the class is eligible to be named the Best Ridden. Entries shall enter the arena at the walk in a clockwise direction. The judge shall request all four gaits (walk, trot, canter, gallop) in at least one direction but animals need not show in both directions.

The judge shall consider the size of the ponies/cobs, ages of riders and safety of arena when determining whether to have the animals perform as a group or individually. Individual pattern is optional at the judge's discretion. Entries shall not be stripped as conformation score from the qualifying class shall be carried forward. Best Ridden shall receive three points, Reserve Best Ridden shall receive 2 points. Points are doubled for Silver shows and tripled for Gold shows.

#### **491. MY FIRST TANDEM CLASSIC**

*Entry Fee: \$40.00/team* Open to All Horses and Ponies. To be shown over a simple course of Cavalettis. Animals may either trot or canter the entire course. Horses to change order part way through the course. Then all exhibitors will return to the ring for a pair under saddle section. To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring.
